Introduction



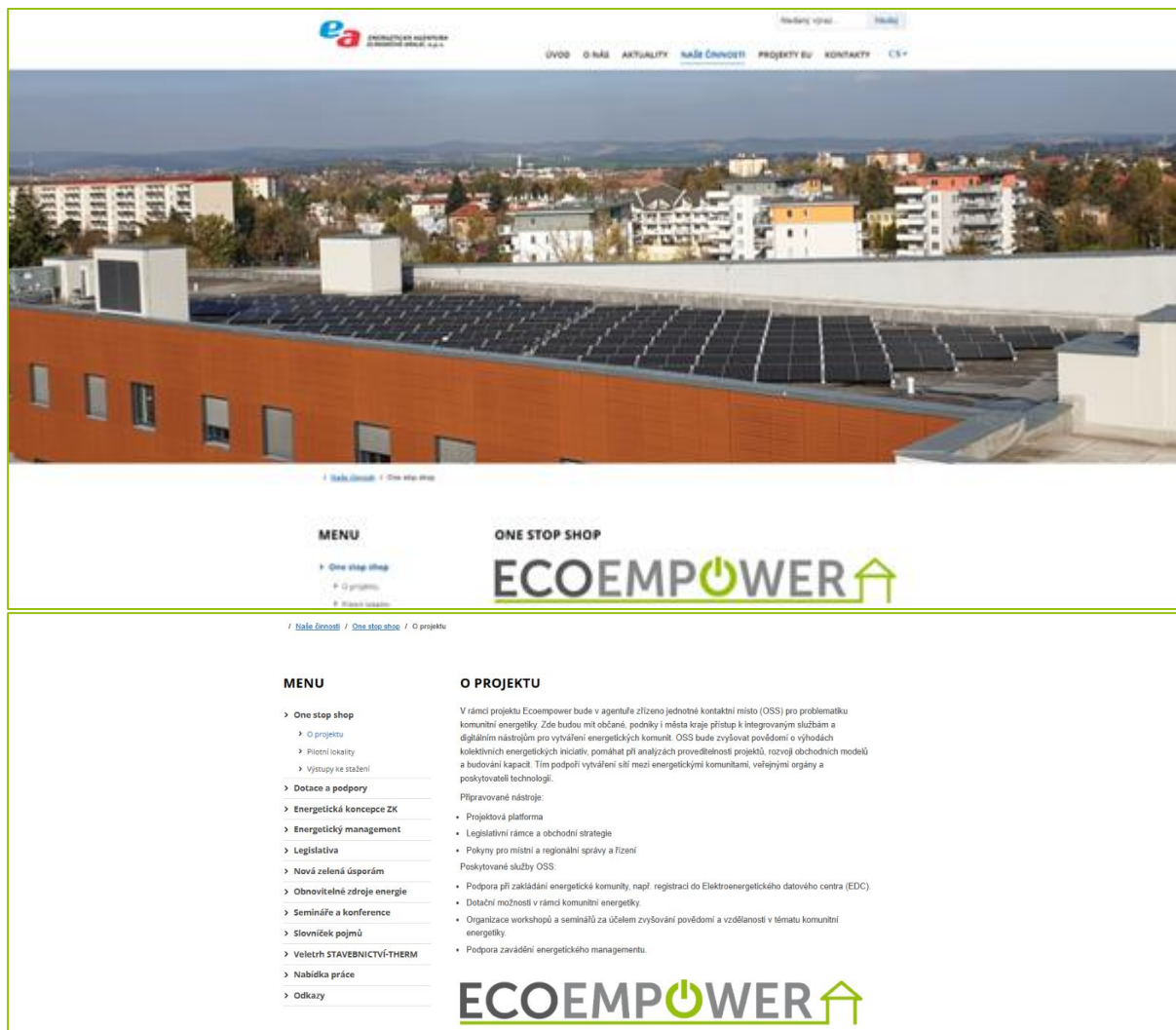
d. Czech Republic - EAZK
